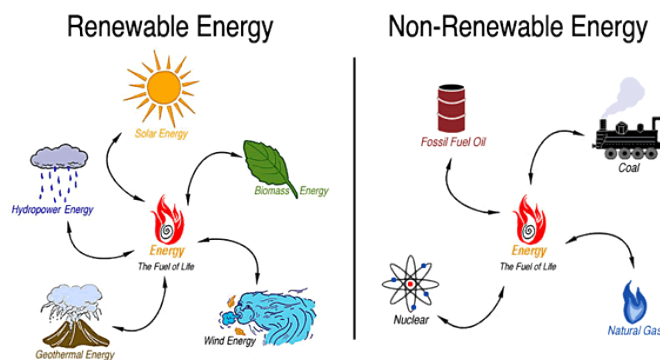


RESOURCE SURVIVAL!

There are many natural resources available on the Earth. These resources can be classified as renewable or non-renewable.

Renewable resources are continually being replaced while non-renewable resources are not replaced fast enough and they could run out. Look at the list of renewable and non-renewable resources. Choose 3 renewable resources and 3 non-renewable resources and write them down. Shuffle the cards and place them face down. The group reveals one card at a time by flipping it over. If you have that resource on your paper you get to cross it off your list. The student who crosses off all of their non-renewable resources first, has used up those resources and has lost the game.

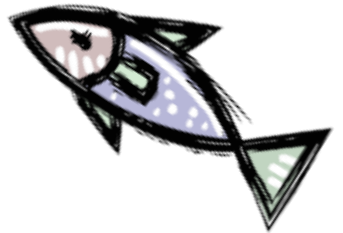
